- Qualitative Studies: 3000 to 4000 words
- Mandatory Registration: All presenters must be registered participants

Presentation Categories

Oral Presentation:

- Duration:
 - Competitive category: 10 minutes
 - Non- Competitive category: 8 minutes
- Format: MS power point (.ppt/.pptx) or PDF
- First Slide: Title of presentation and presenter's name
- Submission deadline for presentation slide: 15th March 2026
- Equipment Provided: Laptop and LED screen with USB access
- Additional Requirement: Submit a brief 5 sentence Introduction about your research area
- Note*: Presentation will be recorded during the conference.

Poster Presentation:

- Display Dimension: Recommended poster size: 3 feet x 6.5 feet
- Board Size: Maximum allowable – 4 feet x 8 feet
- Material: Preferably of Flex
- Poster Number: Must be displayed in the upper left corner

Poster Design Tips:

Theme: Low-Cost Pediatric Set-up

- Content composition: 20 % text, 40 % graphics, 40 % white space
- Use high resolution images only (Web resolution images not permitted)
- Avoid using all Upper-case letters
- Maintain consistent margin, Line spacing, border thickness, colour schemes and shading
- Tables should be legible from 20 feet and body text from 6 feet
- Share the poster to scientific committee in PDF format before deadline
- Submission deadline of Poster: 10th March 2026

Reels:

Theme: - Parents awareness

- Maximum Time: 30 sec.
- It should be Self-created/Original content
- It should have trending Audio & Music
- It should be focused on mentioned theme
- It should not have nudity, violence & hate
- It should not violate any Copyright Law
- It should not hurt anyone religious and social sentiments.
- Share the reels to scientific committee in MPEG4 format before deadline and one reel per participant
- Submission deadline of Reels: 1st March 2026

Short Movies:

CULTURAL EVENT GUIDELINES

All participants here by informed of the rules and regulation for the upcoming cultural event. Participants must strictly adhere to the following guidelines

GROUP DANCE PERFORMANCE

Theme - “Milestones in Motion” – growth through movement”

- Only one team per college is allowed.
- Team size: 8-10 members (including coordinators)
- Time Duration: 3 mins. Exceeding the time limit will result in negative marking.
- Participants may choose any non- offensive song.
- Each team must bring 2 pen drives (one to be submitted on the day of the event)
- Use of fire (match sticks, candles cigarettes, etc.) is strictly prohibited.
- Performance must be decent; indecent steps are not allowed.
- Changing room will be provided.
- Performances should creatively depict developmental milestones of children through expressive movement and dance. The theme emphasizes physical, cognitive, emotional, and social growth, highlighting how movement and play contribute to a child’s overall development—core principles of paediatric occupational therapy.

POETRY RECITATION

- Only one student from each college is allowed.
- Independent clinicians/ professionals are also eligible to participate.
- Time duration- 2 mins
- Performance must be decent; indecent lines or words are not allowed.

Theme-

- “A Therapist’s Promise” expressing the commitment, ethics, and responsibility of an occupational therapist toward children and families.
- “Walking Beside a Child” highlighting family-centred care, empathy, and the therapist’s supportive role in a child’s developmental journey.
- “Where Care Meets Courage” portraying resilience, hope, and the emotional strength of children, caregivers, and therapists.

MIME

- Only one team per college is allowed.
- Team size: 8-10 members (including coordinators)
- Time Duration- 5-7 min.

Theme- “The Unspoken Language of Children” Performances should creatively portray how children communicate their needs, emotions, and experiences beyond words. The theme encourages depiction of non-verbal cues such as gestures, facial expressions, behaviour, play, and movement, highlighting the role of occupational therapy in understanding and supporting children’s communication and participation.

On the spot

- Chit method
- Participants will be given a chit containing a randomly selected topic, situation, or activity related to paediatric occupational therapy. Participants are required to perform or demonstrate an activity based on the chit within the given time, assessing their creativity, spontaneity, understanding, and practical application of occupational therapy concepts.
- Any student or professional is eligible to participate

CULTURAL EVENT GUIDELINES

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FASHION WALK

- Only one team per college is allowed.
- Team size: 10- 12 members (including coordinators)
- Time- 5-7 mins
- Performance must be decent; indecent music or dresses are not allowed.

Theme- “From Clinic to Community” The presentation should creatively demonstrate the transition of children with special needs from therapeutic seatings to real-life community participation. Emphasis should be placed on adaptive clothing, assistive devices, functional independence, confidence, and inclusion, reflecting the role of occupational therapy in enabling meaningful participation beyond the clinic environment.

FACE PAINTING

- Only 1 pair from each college is allowed.
- Participation Format – In Pairs:
- Each entry will consist of two participants, where one participant will perform the face painting and the other will act as the model.
- Time to Explain – 1 Minute:
- Each team will be given 1 minute to explain their artwork on stage, focusing on the concept, emotion depicted, and its relevance to emotional regulation in paediatric occupational therapy.

Theme – “Faces of Emotion: Emotional Regulation”

The artwork should creatively represent different emotions and emotional regulation strategies, highlighting how children recognize, express, and manage emotions—an important component of paediatric occupational therapy.

Special Instruction : This category will commence at the beginning of the cultural program. Participants will start creating their face painting initially, and upon announcement of this category later during the cultural session, teams will present their completed artwork on stage and explain it within the given time limit.
